



TRAINING CENTRE INFORMATION SHEET

A First Aid International™ (FAI) Training Centre provides professional first aid training to its staff and students to internationally recognised standards. The Centre can offer any of the First Aid International™ training programmes.

Application Procedures

To apply for status as an FAI Training Centre, simply contact FAI to request a centre application pack. The application will be processed by FAI Headquarters when all requirements are met. Once all documentation, assessment and training has been satisfied you will be offered Centre Approval.

An FAI Approved Training Centre must:

- Operate as a professional training organisation from premises/facilities that are deemed to be appropriate for that purpose by the FAI Standards Board.
- Have available all essential resources to complete training to FAI Standards and Procedures.
- Have available classroom facilities and audio-visual equipment (television and DVD player or equivalent).
- Secure and continually hold comprehensive professional Employers and Public Liability insurance and supply FAI Headquarters with certificates or other evidence that states the insurance is current.
- Conform to all Standards and Procedures as laid down in the International Registry Handbook.
- Comply (without deviation) to all standards and procedures established by FAI with respect to the use of programmes, materials and instruction.
- Agree to visits from authorised representatives of FAI during normal business hours to monitor the operations and teaching methods, and to review student evaluations.
- Submit all copies of advertising to FAI Headquarters for approval before use, including all brochures, press releases and any other FAI course marketing materials.

All above requirements must be satisfied to qualify for, and to maintain annual status as an FAI Approved Training Centre.

Centre Rewards Scheme

Centre rewards scheme for First Aid International Approved Centres.
